6-8		Science Olympiad	Science Olympiad is a competition team composed of up to 15 students who compete in 23 different events in the areas of physics, chemistry, astronomy, biology, mathematics, coding, and engineering. Our Middle School Science Olympiad will compete in three to four competitions.
3-5		Elementary Science Olympiad	Science Olympiad is a competition team composed of up to 15 students who compete in 15 different events in the areas of physics, chemistry, astronomy, biology, mathematics, coding, and engineering. Our Elementary Science Olympiad will compete in two to three competitions in the Spring of 2026.
3-8		Mathletics	Mathletics is a team of students who compete in the area of mathematics. It is designed to inspire math excellence through competition. Mathletes will compete in at least 2 tournaments during the year.
3-5		Dot & Dash	Dash is a small mobile robot that is full of character and drives around making noises and shining lights. Dot is its sidekick, and it, too, is full of character. The robots help kids learn the basics of robotics and coding.
2-3		Jr. FLL	FIRST® LEGO® League guides students through STEM learning and exploration at an early age. Students will understand the basics of STEM and apply their skills in an exciting competition while building habits of learning, confidence, and teamwork skills along the way.
